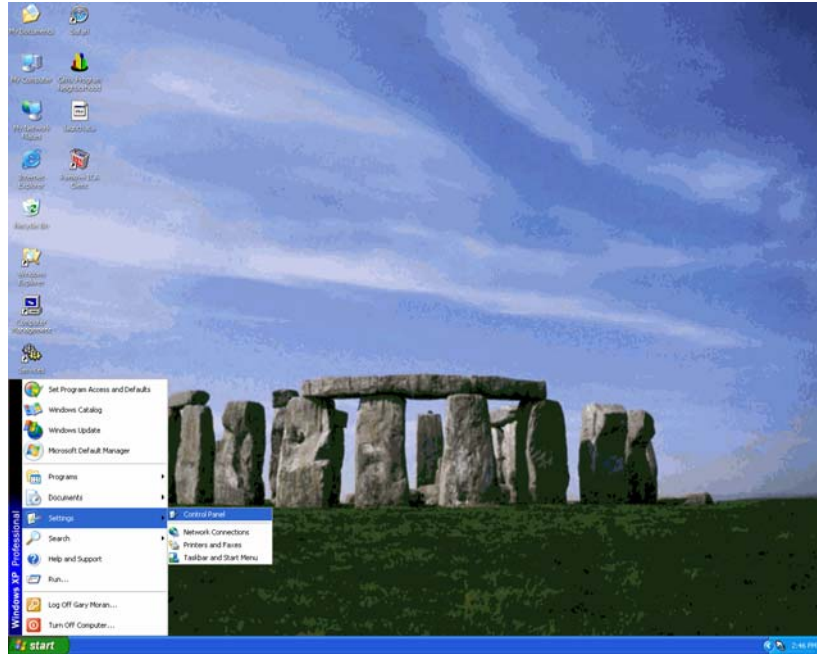


Citrix EDIS Install Document

EDIS Citrix Install

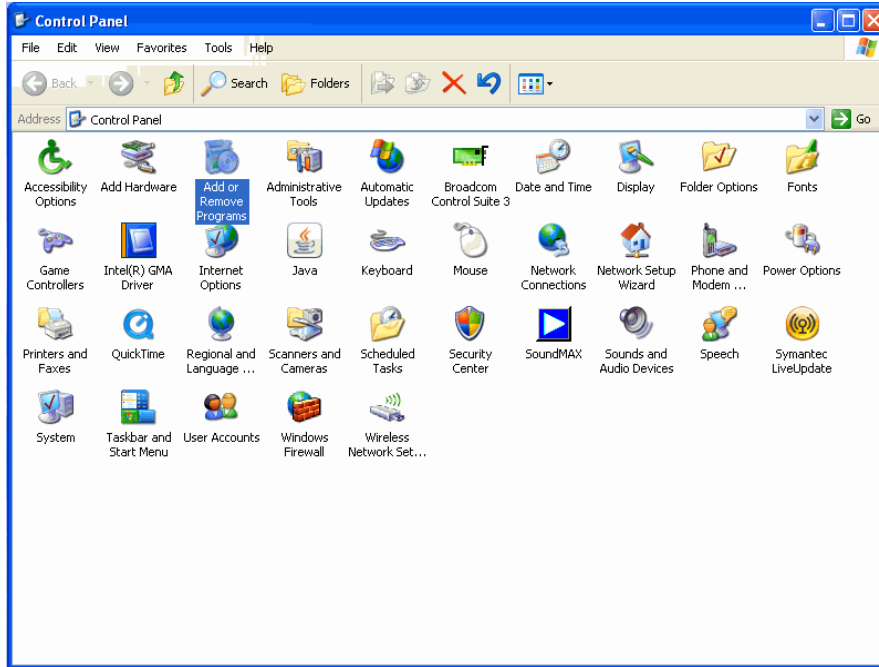
If an old version of Citrix is installed on your PC continue to the next step, otherwise skip to page-5 (How to install Uroam)

An older version of Citrix must be uninstalled from your PC before the Web version of Citrix can be applied. First go to **Start – Control Panel**.

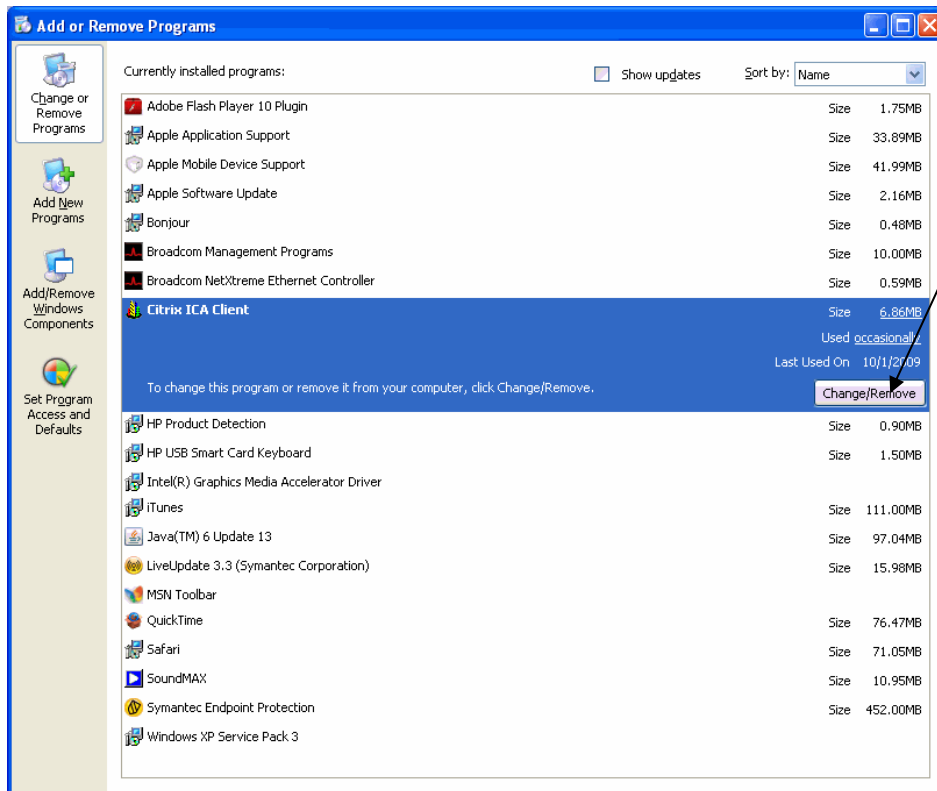

Pick Add and Remove Programs.

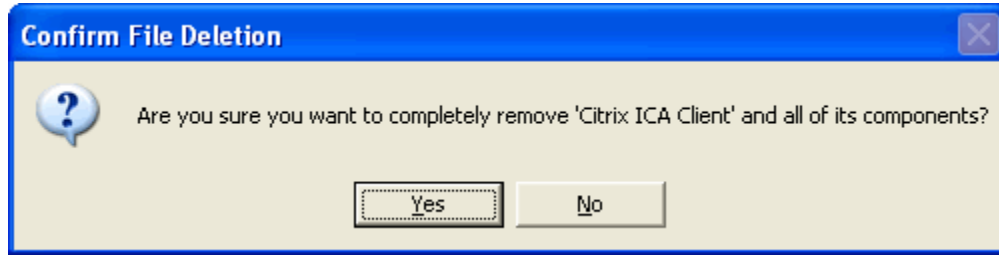


Then locate the program titled **Citrix ICA Client** and pick **Change/Remove** on the right side

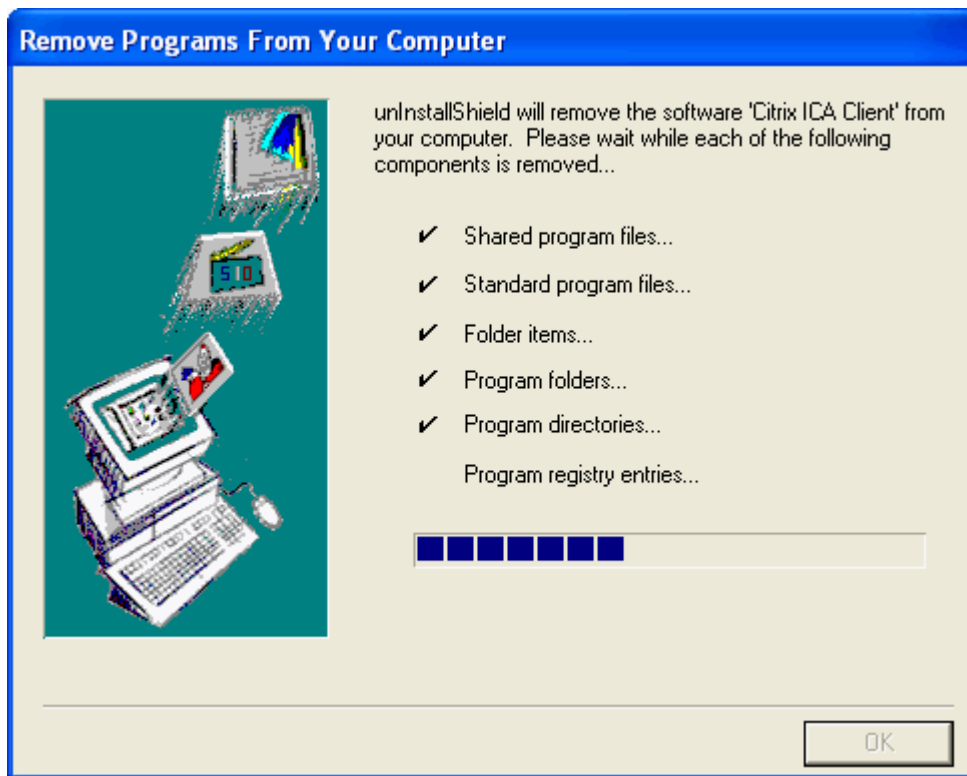

A text box will appear to inform you that you are deleting the Citrix program from your computer. Pick **Yes** to continue and uninstall the program.



Another dialog box will appear showing you the progress of the uninstall.



When it is complete pick **OK**, then close the **Add and Remove Programs** and close **Control Panel**

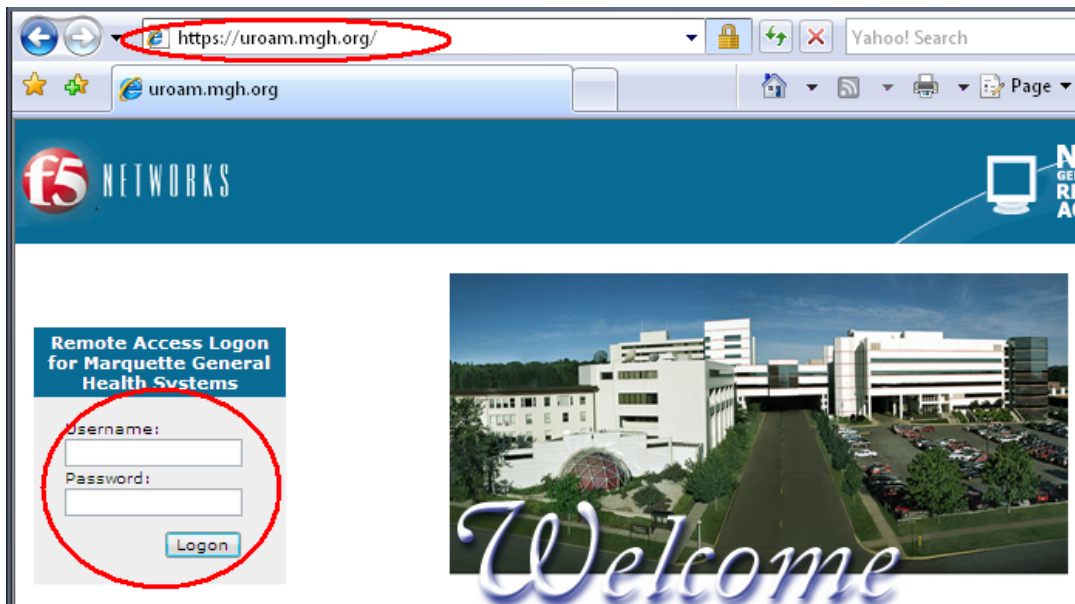

How to install Uroam and Citrix for Users that will be running EDIS.

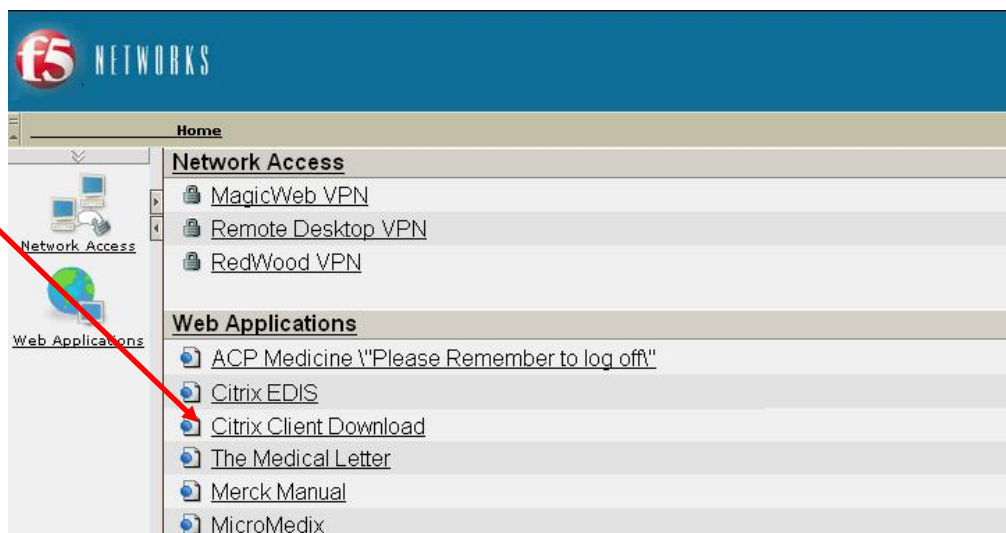
This document is a step by step instruction to guide one through the installation of Uroam and Citrix. Citrix is a program that will allow you to run EDIS on a network outside of MGH.

- 1.) From a web browser go to: <https://uroam.mgh.org>
 - Enter your Username and Password.

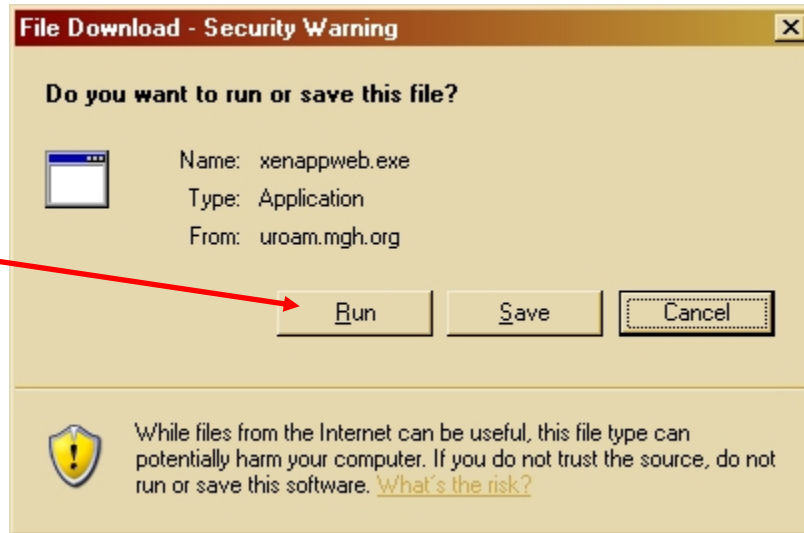


- Click on Citrix Client Download.

- 2.) The File Download Security Warning will automatically come up to either **run** or **save** the file. To begin the install click on “**Run**”.

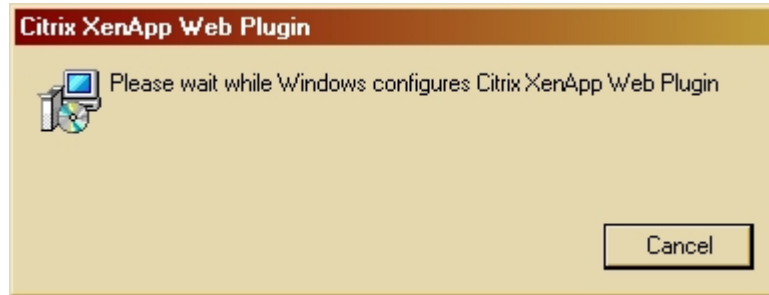


- 3.) The Internet Explorer – Security Warning will appear. To begin the install click on **Run**.

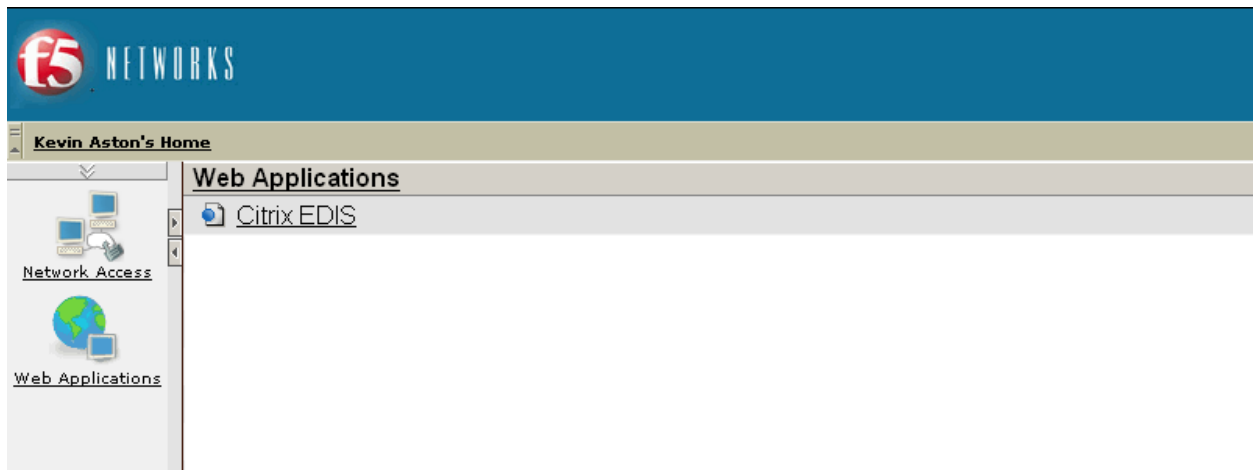

- 4.) Once the Citrix Client begins to install you will have the progress bar appear. When the installation is complete the dialog box should close.

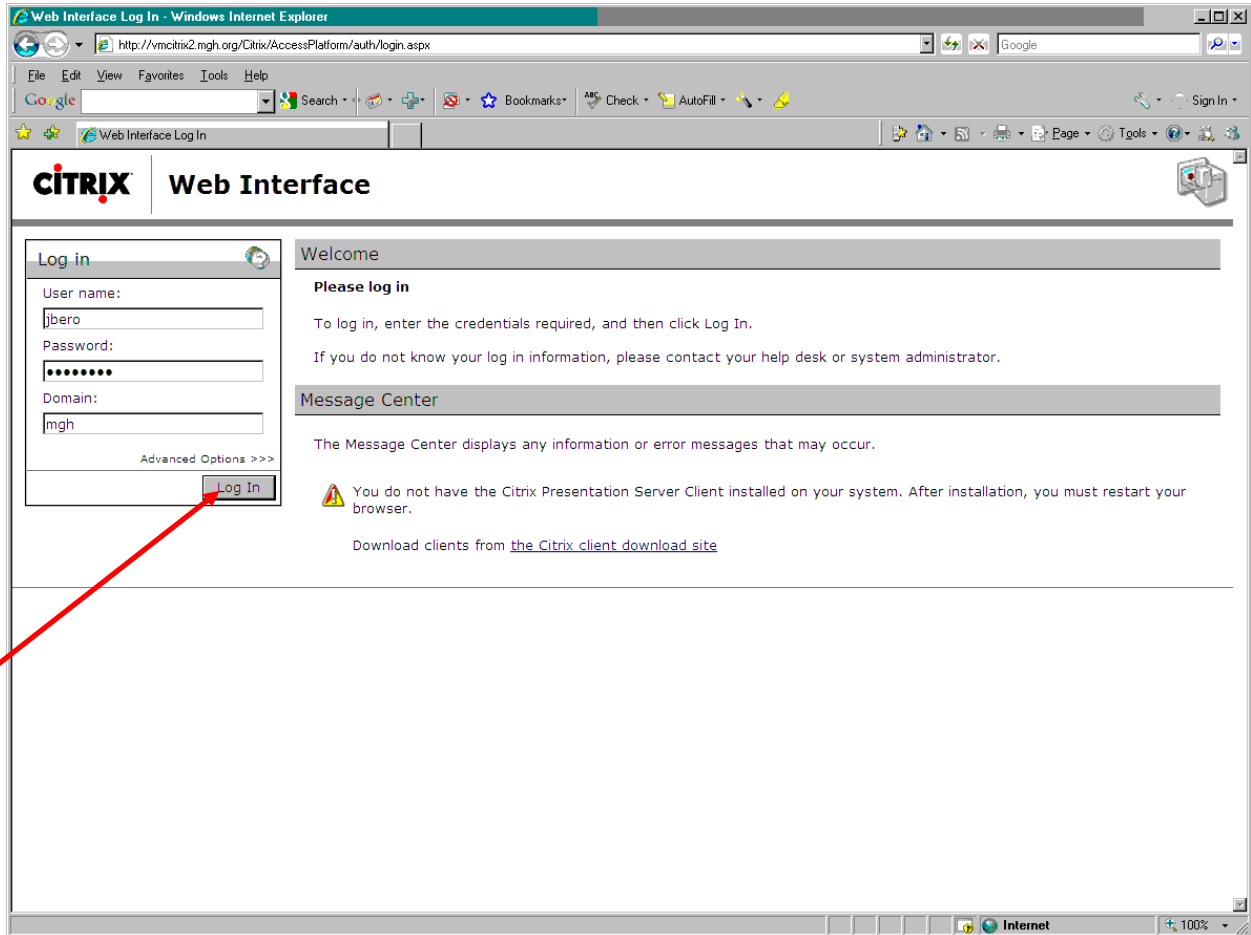


- 5.) Once Citrix XenApp Plugin has completed installing the application, launch the Citrix EDIS button on the FirePass page.

6.) You will be directed to the Webpage <http://vmcitrix2.mgh.org>

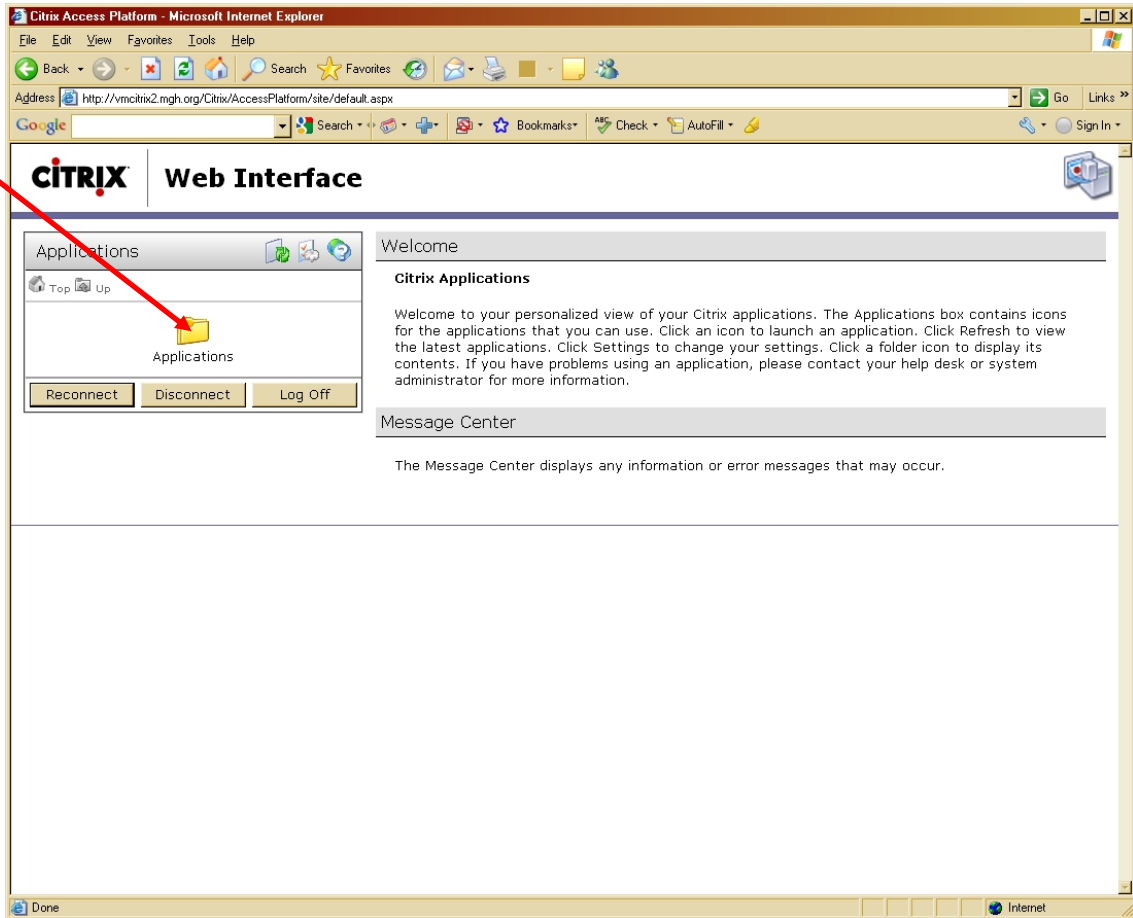


When the Login page appears Use your standard Active Directory (network) **Username** and **Password** with the Domain being **mgh**. Then click on **Log In**

If you have an existing Network account you will be logged in and the webpage below will appear.

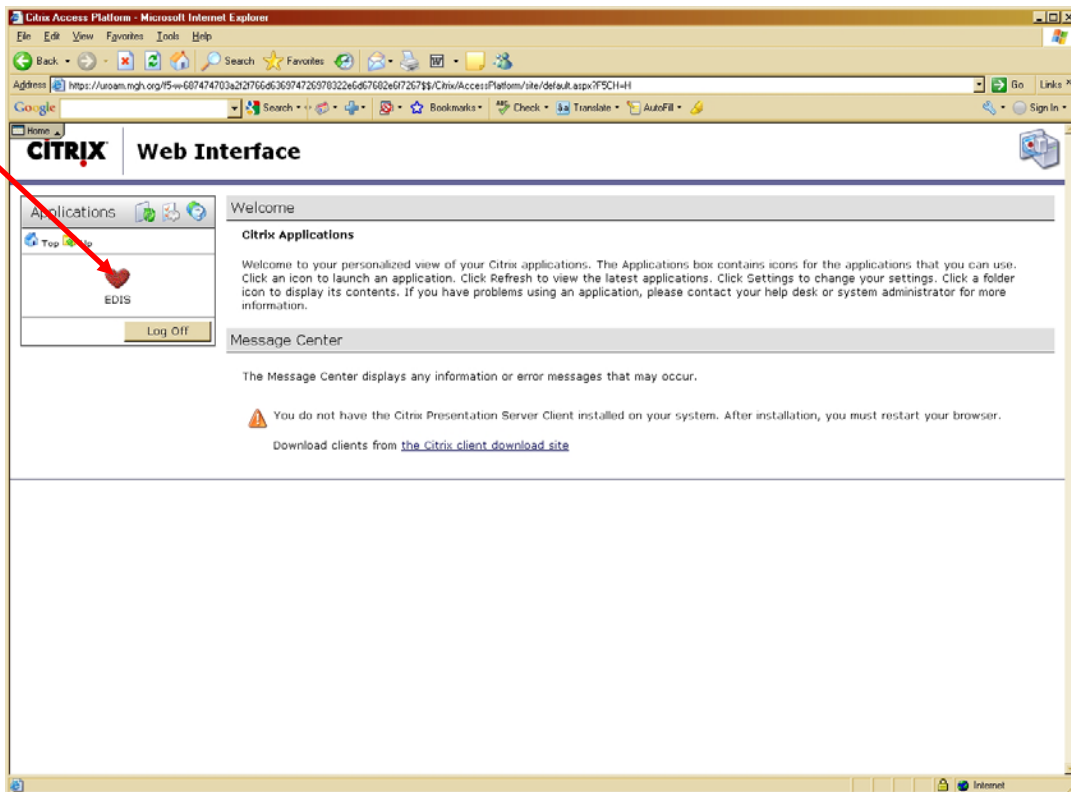

7.) Click on **Applications** ICON



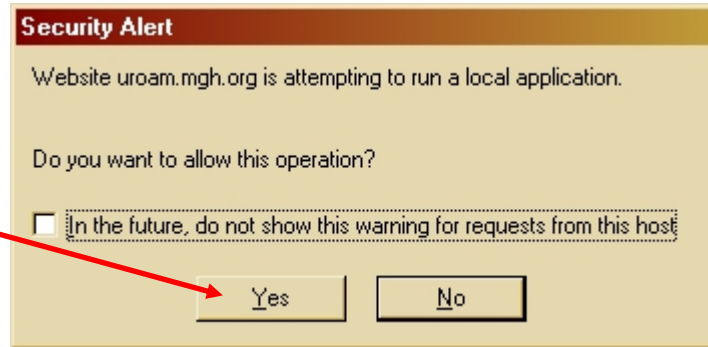

8.) The Applications page will appear click on EDIS ICON

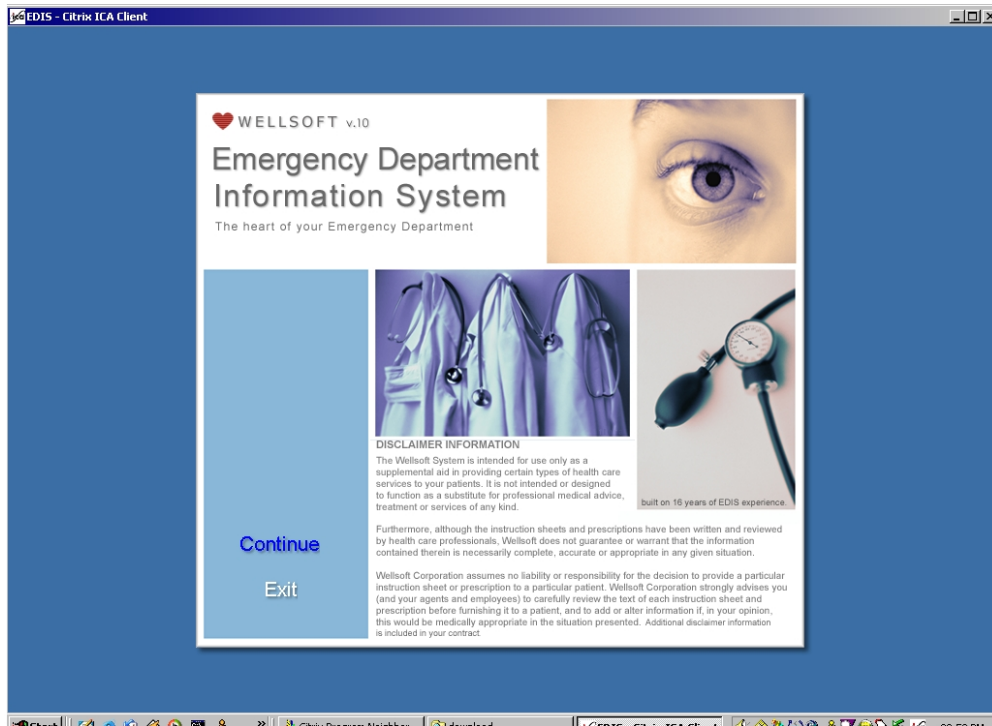
