## PROGRAM OVERVIEW/TARGET AUDIENCE

Resuscitation and stabilization of infants and children at risk for cardiac/respiratory arrest requires professionals with specialized knowledge and training.

This course has been designed to provide information necessary in the recognition and management of the infant or child at risk of cardiopulmonary arrest, and the opportunity to practice the psychomotor skills necessary for resuscitation and stabilization.

The PALS Course is intended for pediatricians, emergency physicians, family physicians, nurses, paramedics, EMT's, respiratory therapists, members of code/arrest teams, and other health care professionals that provide services for infants and children. Because of recent changes in the course, **students must be proficient in rhythm recognition, pharmacology, and BLS skills and knowledge. These will not be taught at the course.**

## ADMISSION

A current PALS card is required to participate in the Renewal course. **Please enclose a current copy of your PALS card with your application for the PALS Renewal course.**

## CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS

**Physicians**—Marquette General Hospital is accredited by the Michigan State Medical Society Committee on CME Accreditation to provide continuing medical education for physicians. Marquette General Hospital designates this educational activity for a maximum of 16 credit hours for the PALS Provider Course in Category 1 and 8 credit hours for the PALS Renewal Course in Category 1 towards the AMA Physicians Recognition Award. Each physician should claim only those hours of credit that he/she actually spent in the educational activity.

**Nurses**—The Michigan Board of Nursing considers certification in basic & advanced life support by the American Heart Association as providing acceptable continuing education for relicensure.

**EMS**—Meets criteria for standardized EMS continuing education credits.
