PROGRAM OVERVIEW/TARGET AUDIENCE

Resuscitation and stabilization of infants and children at risk for cardiac/respiratory arrest requires professionals with specialized knowledge and training.

This course has been designed to provide information necessary in the recognition and management of the infant or child at risk of cardiopulmonary arrest, and the opportunity to practice the psychomotor skills necessary for resuscitation and stabilization.

The PALS Course is intended for pediatricians, emergency physicians, family physicians, nurses, paramedics, EMT's, respiratory therapists, members of code/arrest teams, and other health care professionals that provide services for infants and children. Because of recent changes in the course, **students must be proficient in rhythm recognition, pharmacology, and BLS skills and knowledge. These will not be taught at the course.**

ADMISSION

A current PALS card is required to participate in the Renewal course. **Please enclose a current copy of your PALS card with your application for the PALS Renewal course.**

CONTINUING EDUCATION CREDITS

Physicians – The Marquette General Health System is accredited by the Michigan State Medical Society to provide continuing medical education for physicians. The Marquette General Health System designates this educational activity for a maximum of *16 AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s)*™ for PALS Provider Course and *8 AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s)*™ for PALS Renewal Course.

Nurses – The Michigan Board of Nursing considers certification in basic & advanced life support by the American Heart Association as providing acceptable continuing education for relicensure.
