Objectives: At the conclusion of this presentation, student will be able to recognize pulmonary emboli and provide appropriate treatment.

- Knowledge:**
1. The student will be able to define pulmonary emboli.
 2. The student will be able to identify signs and symptoms of pulmonary emboli.
 3. The student will be able to complete a detailed assessment to determine treatment.
 4. The student will be able to prioritize treatments.
 5. The student will be able to explain why sequence of treatment was done.
 6. The student will be able to evaluate their course of treatment for effectiveness.

- Affective:**
1. The student will accept the need for fast response in treatment of pulmonary emboli.
 2. The student will be challenged in the role of EMT lead in the treatment and care of a patient with pulmonary emboli.
 3. The student will choose and defend their treatment.
 4. The student will judge their treatment based on how it affects the PE patient.
 5. The student will consistently apply the correct course of treatment and re-evaluate their course of treatment.
