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**Protocols:**

The Protocols Committee regularly meets and consists of individuals from all EMS levels, nursing and our physician directors. The Protocols Committee develops, reviews, revises, and distributes all Marquette County EMS protocols and procedures for adoption by the Medical Control Authority Board. Protocols and procedures are currently undergoing a massive re-write. Your input is encouraged!

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**Professional Standards Review Organization:**

This committee regularly meets to overview quality assurance activities including review of prehospital patient care reports and agency internal QI reports. All agencies are required to submit copies of their patient care reports and internal QI reports to the Medical Control Authority. The PSRO may also review any prehospital care complaints or concerns.

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**Communications Committee:**

The Communications Committee meets when necessary to address all interagency communication issues, including the MedCom requirements. The Committee relates applicable findings to the Marquette County Central Dispatch Authority.

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**Automated External Defibrillation Committee:**

The AED Committee was established to review the training, purchasing, and use of AEDs in Marquette County to assure the consistency and quality of the program. This committee develops, reviews, and approves all AED-related programs and protocols in the county. This committee will meet regularly when programmatic changes occur.

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**Pharmacy Committee:**

The Pharmacy Committee is responsible for any medications provided by licensed EMS agencies in Marquette County. This committee meets as necessary for recommendations to the Medical Control Authority on the use, security, and documentation of all medications that are carried by EMS. Both hospital pharmacies from Bell Memorial and Marquette General Hospital are consulted since there is responsibility to the State Board of Pharmacy for medications carried prehospital.

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**Training Committee:**

The Training Committee assesses the educational needs of the EMS providers in the county, including initial and ongoing training. This committee is instrumental to assuring changes in protocols or procedures are delivered to the EMS agencies, and they meet as necessary.

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**Operations and Interagency Relations Committee:**

This committee addresses all issues that arise between EMS life support agencies and/or the participating hospitals that have been unresolved at the EMS service/agency level. The committee meets on an as-needed basis to review any concerns raised in Marquette County.
