Annual Renewal for EMT-S and Paramedics

Part 2; Section 1
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The Marquette County EMS Medical Control Authority will review and approve annually all EMT-Specialists and Paramedics actively working in Marquette County with one of the participating agencies. The requirements of EMT-Specialists and Paramedics are noted below.

EMT-Specialists who are licensed by the MDCIS but are working solely with an agency licensed as a non-transporting first responder agency, medical first responder agency, or basic life support ambulance agency will not be required to complete the EMT-Specialist review and approval process.

Paramedics who are licensed by the MDCIS, but are working solely with an agency that is licensed as a non-transporting first responder agency, medical first responder agency, basic life support ambulance agency, or limited advanced life support agency will not be required to complete the Paramedic review and approval process.

- EMT-Specialists and Paramedics working in the Marquette County EMS Medical Control Authority based on the above guidelines will meet all requirements as defined by the Michigan Department of Consumer and Industry Services to hold current licensure at such level.
- Ongoing renewal requirements are to be met prior to allowing any lapse of the licensure period. Providers who allow their license to expire will not operate or provide services with any Marquette County EMS Medical Control Authority agency before written verification of licensure is received.
- EMT-Specialists will maintain current certification in an approved BCLS program and will meet all renewal requirements.
- Paramedics will maintain current certification in an approved ACLS program and will meet all renewal requirements. This includes maintaining current BCLS certification at all times.

Annually, all EMT-Specialists and Paramedics who are active in the Marquette County EMS Medical Control Authority system will be reviewed and approved by the Medical Control Authority Medical Director or the Medical Control Authority Assistant Medical Director, based on their agency's location. All agencies in the Marquette County EMS Medical Control Authority are required to submit a roster of active personnel annually when re-licensing their agency. The EMT-S and Paramedic providers on these rosters will be reviewed by the Medical Director or Assistant Medical Director, and an approval letter will be forwarded to the agency. Any concerns regarding the approval of the EMT-S or Paramedics will be addressed with the Medical Director, the Service Director and the provider.
