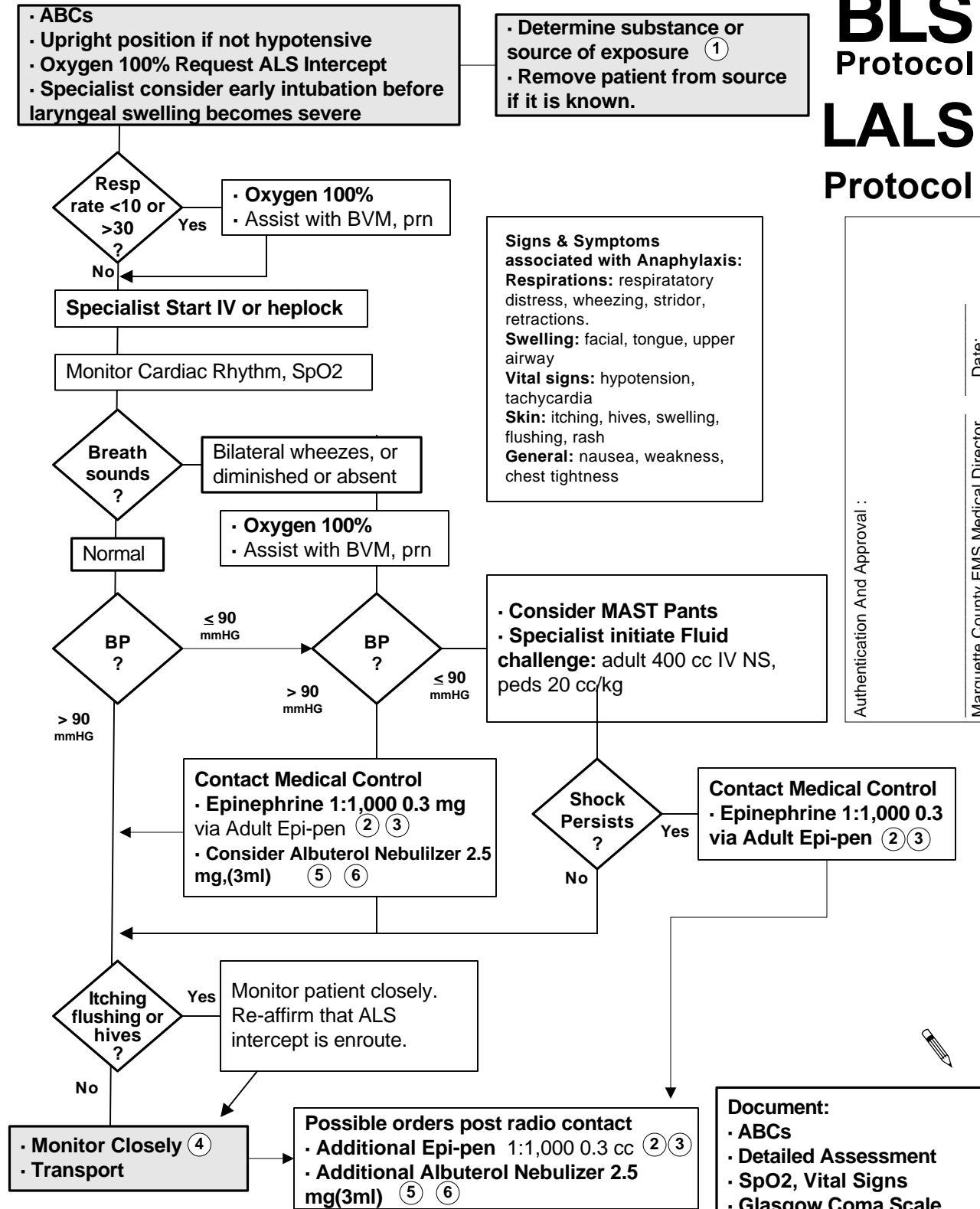

Signs & Symptoms associated with Anaphylaxis:
Respirations: respiratory distress, wheezing, stridor, retractions.
Swelling: facial, tongue, upper airway
Vital signs: hypotension, tachycardia
Skin: itching, hives, swelling, flushing, rash
General: nausea, weakness, chest tightness

- 1 Bee sting: gently remove stinger if still present.
- 2 Epi-pen: Adult dose is for patients weighing 66 lb or more
- 3 Epi-pen: Pediatric dose = for patients weighing between 33 and 66 lbs
- 4 Contact Medical Control if symptoms/signs persist.
- 5 Albuterol: pediatric dose 5 years old and under: 1.25 mg Albuterol in 1.5+ ml saline to bring total fluid up to 3 ml in nebulizer.
- 6 Administration of nebulized Albuterol by approved-services only.
