

BABY CAP DIRECTIONS

Size #5 needles

3-ply baby yarn (Red Hart Soft or similar)

Cast on 56 stitches.

K2, P2 or K1, P1 for 2 inches.

K1 row, P1 row, for 2 ½ inches.

Decrease as follows:

1 - K5, K2 together to end of row.

2 - Purl across.

3 - K4, K2 together to end.

4 - Purl across.

5 - K3, K2 together to end.

6 - Purl across.

7 - K2, K2 together.

8 - Purl across.

9 - Last row, K2 together across.

Cut yarn. Pull through stitches to close top.

Sew with yarn down side, which will be back seam.

Make yarn pompom for top.

Finished caps can be dropped off to the Volunteer Office at Marquette General Hospital, East Entrance (to the right of the lobby). Yarn is also available in the Volunteer Office. If you have any questions, feel free to call the Volunteer Office at 225-3280.
